Dear Sir

I am pleased to inform you that Bracton Glass Washing Detergent submitted by your company has been assessed by Carlton's Customer Quality Services Department and has met the standards which we consider desirable in any product used in connection with the dispensing of beer.

As a result of the successful testing of your product the Company, (Carlton and United Breweries Limited), is prepared to let you state that your product meets the standards considered desirable by the Company subject to the following conditions.

- i. The Company may only be quoted as being satisfied that your product met the standards desirable in any product used in connection with the dispensing of beer and NOT as having recommended the use of your product.
- ii. Where the Company is quoted in any literature which is given to customers, relating to your product, such quotation must only state that the product has met standards considered desirable by the Company and should not indicate recommendation. Further, the quotation must be limited to a twelve month period from the date of initial laboratory testing, which date must be specified.

It is the Company's policy to review all products which met the relevant standards prior to expiry of every twelve month period from the date the products were last tested. If tests show that the products are still meeting these standards then manufacturers are notified accordingly.

- iii. The Company must be notified of any intended change to the formulation of your product to ensure that we are not quoted in respect of a product different for that originally tested.

- iv. The Company reserves the right to withdraw samples of your product from the trade, at any time during the twelve month approval period, and test it against the relevant company specification.

If the results show that the product tested is not of the same specification that was originally submitted, the Company may, at its discretion, immediately withdraw its permission for you to state that your product meets the Company's standards pending rectification or explanation. In the event of our permission being withdrawn, the Company must not be quoted by you in respect of the subject product.
